

- \$1 billion codes program RFI from SCEP
- ALRD for the implementation of Home Energy Performance-Based, Whole House Rebates (HOMES) and the High-Efficiency Electric Home Rebate (HEEHR) programs (Inflation Reduction Act, Sec 50121 and 50122)
- Energy Auditor Training Grant Program FOA (expected by Q1 2023)

## Framing Questions:

- Are there any new legislation or docket items that might advance building efficiency or electrification initiatives in your state? (e.g., utility data access mandates, renewable portfolio standards, new state or utility-run incentive programs)
- Are any federal funding opportunities (other than rebates) you are focused on or concerned about? If so, which ones and why?
- Have notable interagency, community-based, or even regional partnerships emerged in the past few months in order to advance building energy efficiency and clean energy initiatives?
- Are there technologies in focus for scaling statewide building efficiency or clean energy efforts (e.g., weatherization measures, all-electric appliances, demand responsive appliances, onsite storage and generation)
- What are the building sectors of focus within your state (e.g., publicly-owned buildings, K-12 schools, large commercial buildings, multifamily buildings)? Are the performance of these building sector tied to statewide energy or climate goals?
- Are there restrictions on hiring State Energy Office for the administration of federal programs to support building improvement efforts? How are shortages in the auditor, builder, and contractor workforce for implementing building upgrades being addressed?
